Warranty Details

How do I qualify for the Warranty?

- > Must be the original owner or lessee of a passenger car, sport utility vehicle, or pickup truck with a gross vehicle weight under 8,000 pounds. Rental and lease fleet vehicles and vehicles used in competitive events or for commercial purposes are excluded.
- > Vehicle must have less than 75,000 miles at the time it's registered.
- > Must have records to show that the vehicle was serviced in accordance with the manufacturer's recommended maintenance schedule, using the correct oil quality and viscosity.
- > Must submit the Warranty application by mail or online at www.uslube.com/warranty.

What engine parts are covered by the Warranty?

- > Pistons and Piston Rings
- > Crankshaft and Bearings
- > Connecting Rods
- > Push Rods
- > Valve Stems and Steel Guides (steel only)
- > Valve Lifters
- > Distributor Drive Gear
- > Oil Pump and Timing Chains
- > Rocker Arms and Pivots
- > Rod Bearings
- > Cam Shaft and Bearings
- > Wrist Pins and Bushings
- > Cylinder Lining or Bore
- > Timing Gears or Steel Sprockets (steel only)

How do I make sure my Warranty stays valid?

You must have documentation which shows that the appropriate grade of THRIVE Premium Motor Oil and new oil filter (air filter when required) were installed continuously from the date / mileage of registration in the program and that:

- > Oil was installed by a car dealer, quick lube, or other professional auto service center
- > Oil changes were performed at mileage or time intervals and with API viscosity grade recommended by the engine manufacturer, but not more than 5,000 miles or 6 months, whichever comes first
- > All scheduled maintenance was performed in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendation in the warranty manual
- > Maintenance records can be updated at: www.uslube.com/warranty

What does my Warranty NOT cover?

- > Damage that occurred prior to the coverage commencement date
- > Pre-existing conditions which may be verified by a spectro-chemical analysis of the crank case oil, at U.S. Lubricants' discretion
- > Damage caused by a collision or accident
- > Negligent or intentional abuse
- > Improper service, maintenance, or installation of parts
- > Repairs covered under the original manufacturer's warranty or covered under any extended warranties
- > Defects in the manufacture of engine parts
- > Failure to maintain engine oil or coolant levels as recommended by the manufacturer
- > Failure to perform maintenance as recommended at regular service intervals

How long is my Warranty valid?

10 years or 300,000 miles from the date the vehicle was first purchased, whichever comes first.

How do I make a Warranty Claim?

You must notify the U.S. Lubricants Warranty Claims Coordinator (1-800-490-4900) before any repairs are performed. U.S. Lubricants reserves the right to direct the repairs to a particular repair facility, to be specified in advance of the actual repair.
